



Sample Itinerary

Here is an idea of what your private trip could look like.

Day 1 - Starting the route

Today we head onto the trail together. Your guide will have gotten you geared up at the trailhead or possibly the night before at your lodging. We will start mid morning or around lunch. The meeting spot is the trailhead parking lot. Trail, map and backpack briefings and off we go! Our first day tends to be a little shorter to accommodate for acclimating to the activity. Along the way we will enjoy lunch. When we arrive at our camp we will learn how to set up our home for safety, ease, and comfort. As we rest and explore, your guide will cook up a delicious meal for everyone to enjoy together.

Day 2 - Hike and Explore

Wake up to the smell of freshly brewed coffee and your guide preparing a warm breakfast. As we eat together, we will talk about our route and what lies ahead. After, we will break camp, pack up our belongings and hit the trail. We will enjoy a lunch along the way before reaching our next camp. On average, miles range from 3 - 8 per day on variable terrain.



Day 3 - Hike, maybe a swim

Each day we will have the same routine. Each camp will be our own private space and it is determined by our permit. We won't have to share with any other groups. Some sites allow fires and some do not. In addition, some of our routes are near water and people enjoy fishing or swimming in the water.



Day 4 - Last day

On the last morning, most people are feeling confident, proud, and awe-struck by their experience. Raving about the meals they've eaten, the stars they have gazed at each night, and the wildlife that shared space with the group. It is a bitter-sweet feeling to head back to flushing toilets and showers.

Our hiking route will lead us back to our parking lot, where we will unpack and say our goodbyes. Your guide will have tips and recommendations for you to go into the parks for a more touristy experience. We want you to see all Yellowstone has to offer and get your souvenirs!
